Non-burnable garbage

Garbage that cannot be burned due to its material.

Broken glass and sharp knives should be wrapped in paper or other material to prevent injury.

Non-burnable garbage

Metal or ceramic cookware, tableware, pottery, glassware, iron products, bottle and can caps (metallic), umbrellas, small household appliances, oily or dirty bottles, canned food tins, etc.



Please wrap knives, broken glass, broken bottles, etc. in newspaper to prevent danger. Small household appliances such as hair dryers and rice cookers can only be disposed off if they fit into the designated bag for "non-burnable garbage."

Dangerous garbage

Batteries, lighters, spray cans, fluorescent lights, etc., are classified as [dangerous waste]. Please do not dispose of them together with [non-burnable waste].



Bottle

Bottles that are not oily or dirty should be disposed off as "Bottles".

If a bottle breaks, wrap it in newspaper or other paper and dispose of it as "non-burnable garbage".
